Conditions:

- Possess and demonstrate a profound passion for Jesus Christ, God's Word, and people. It should be evidenced by personal spiritual growth and a desire to grow in the knowledge of the Bible with a desire to invest these things into the lives of others.
- Possess a humble spirit with a servant's heart.

- Meet regularly with the pastoral staff to consult, report and pray for the needs of church ministries.
- Sign the Pastoral Covenant as outlined in the church constitution and be in agreement with the LVBC Statement of Faith, its Constitution and By-Laws.
